

If you are in active treatment (IV or oral chemotherapy/medications), or follow-up care for your cancer or hematologic diagnosis, there will no longer be a provider to order medications for you at Celilo Medical Oncology. It will be necessary for you to transfer your care to another facility or discuss other options with your primary care provider.

We will be happy to assist you in transferring your care to an available oncologist/ hematologist. Additionally, there may be elements of your care that we will still be able to provide for you at Celilo Cancer Center. This can be determined by your new oncologist/ hematologist.

Process for Obtaining Medical Records:

If you are transferring to an OHSU affiliate, no record transfer is required.

Once a transfer facility is identified, call the MCMC Medical Records Department at 541-296-7294. They will send these records to the new facility on your behalf or you may request to pick up a hard copy.

Available Services:

Radiation Oncology remains fully functional and will continue to treat current patients and accept new patient referrals.

Surgical Cancer Care continues to be available:

- General Surgery including breast cancer, colon cancer and surgery for access ports
- Urology for prostate and urological cancers
- ENT for head and neck cancers

Infusion, Injection, Bladder Installation:

If you come to Celilo for an infusion, injection or bladder installation ordered by a provider not associated with an oncologist or hematologist at Celilo Medical Oncology, our dedicated nurses will still be able to administer your infusions and injections.

Therapeutic Phlebotomy patients will need orders from a hematologist outside of Celilo Cancer Center. The administration of this service is still available to you.

LABS:

We will no longer have dedicated lab services at Celilo Cancer Center, however we will still be able to support those patients who need device access care (implanted ports, PICC lines).
